Nick Mitchell-Bennett

Nick is the Executive Director of the Community Development Corporation of Brownsville in Brownsville, TX. During his time with the CDC of Brownsville Nick assisted in leading the efforts to create an innovative, effective approach to housing reconstruction after natural disasters known as RAPIDO. The Disaster Recovery Housing pilot program uses a temporary-to-permanent housing strategy that deploys a core temporary housing unit to a family's property. Later, the family collaborates with architects and local contractors to custom-design the expansion of the core according to their needs. Currently, there are 21 RAPIDO homes in the RGV.


We look forward to having Nick join us to talk about rapid rehousing following a disaster.

Clean Energy Works was founded by Dr. Holmes Hummel to accelerate investments in the dean energy economy with inclusive financing. As the champion for the Pay As You Save (PAYS) system, Dr. Hummel led Clean Energy Works to win the FiRe Award for high-impact innovation at the Bloomberg New Energy Finance "Future of Energy Summit." Dr. Hummel also serves on the board of Cornerstone Capital as well as Cleantech Open. Previously, Dr. Hummel served as the Senior Policy Advisor in the Department of Energy's Office of Policy & International Affairs from 2009-2013. In addition to prior work with energy innovators in the Silicon Valley, Dr. Hummel earned a doctorate degree from Stanford University for interdisciplinary research on energy technology scenarios that achieve 100% clean energy for all.
